



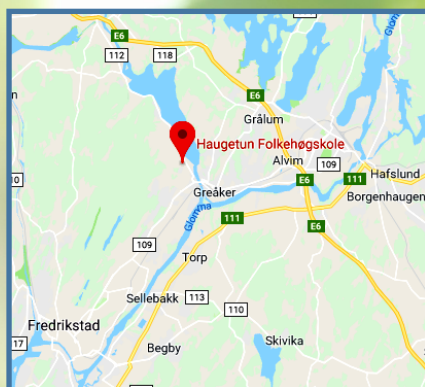

Our Bishops will be there to encourage and guide us.



H augetun folkehøyskole

is situated in the countryside half way (ca. 8 km) between Fredrikstad and Sarpsborg. The school facilities include a large living/dining room, a small chapel, a huge gym with a stage, a cinema, arts and crafts room, sports room, a lovely outdoor area, a sand volleyball field and other nice facilities. The Fredrikstadmarka—a wood with beautiful paths is close by.

P rices

Participants 12 years +: NOK 1700, Children 4-11 years: NOK 850

Children below 4 years: FREE Booking fee: NOK 250 per family

The prices include three nights at Haugetun Boarding School, all meals and a visit to the Old Town and St. Birgitta Church in Fredrikstad. Travel costs are not included.

H ow to get there

Driving by car, or if you come by air or train to Oslo, you can go to Haugetun in any of the following ways:

- From Oslo Airport, take the airport bus, «Flybussen» FB11, straight to Fredrikstad Bus Terminal (ca. 2 hrs)
- From Oslo Central station, train R20 to Fredrikstad station (ca. 1h 10min).
- From Oslo Bus Terminal: Bus VY6 every hour to Fredrikstad Bus Terminal (1h 20min)

Arriving from Iceland or Denmark at Torp Sandefjord Airport:

- From Torp station, train to Oslo R11, then train R20 to Fredrikstad station
- From Torp airport, pre-order tickets for Torp Ekspressen to Oslo Bus Terminal, then train R20 to Fredrikstad station
- Pre-order Paulsenbuss to Horten, take the Bastø ferry to Moss, then train R20 to Fredrikstad.

We will organize pick up services at Fredrikstad Central Station and Bus Terminal every hour **between 12 p.m. and 4 p.m. May 26th, and after 2 p.m. May 29th.**

A ccommodation



Families will be lodged in the number of single and double rooms they need, some of them with individual bathrooms, others with shared facilities. The school provides extra mattresses for children. Bring a baby cot if you need. Youth 12+ will be accommodated on mattresses in class rooms. You may check out www.haugetun.no/internat/ and get acquainted with the place.
